Sample Bequest Language

A bequest – a gift in your will – is a simple and convenient way to make a future gift to Stony Brook University. Below are several examples of suggested bequest wording which you may share with your legal counsel if you would like to make a gift to Stony Brook University through your will or living trust.

Your gift can be a specific dollar amount or a percentage of your estate. You can choose to leave your gift for general use, or you can restrict its use. Most important however, we want to thank you for including Stony Brook University in your estate plan.
